- (b) if only conclusion II follows.
- (c) if either I or II follows.
- (d) if neither I nor Il follows; and
- (e) if both I and II follow.
- 1. **Statement:** Many people and media alleged that Mr. X, the opposition leader, met the Chief Minister yesterday to seek certain favours, an allegation which was strongly rejected by Mr X.

#### **Conclusions:**

- 2. (d)
- 3. (c) It is clearly mentioned that the project of road construction has crossed its first deadline. Therefore. Option (d) is not correct.
  - The Conclusion the work of the road is going on is true
- 4. (a) The cost of transportation from state A to state C is more than 30% of the production cost can be directly drawn from the statement.
- 5. (a) Conclusion I follows as it is directly implied by the given statement.
  - Conclusion II does not follow because it is too severe.

- 6. (a) Conclusion I follows as it is mentioned in the given statement that chances of heart ailments are greatly reduced by a regular half-hour exercise.
  - Conclusion II does not follow because of the word 'definitely'.
- 7. (b) It's a laptop for all. The statement says students will get an offer that does not mean other can't buy it. So I does not follow. Since students are given an offer we can conclude that Lenovo wants students to buy their laptops. So II follow.
- 8. (d) I is an assumption. II is a suggestion but not a conclusion. Hence, neither I nor II follows.
